	There are 4 ways we would like to change care in Teignmouth and Dawlish.			
1	This is the 1st thing that we would like to do.			
	We would like people to go to the Health and Wellbeing Centre in Teignmouth. For some people, this will be instead of going to Teignmouth Community Hospital. These would be the people who go to “community clinics”.			

	“Community clinics” are for local people. In community clinics people go to see a health worker close to where they live. The new Health and Wellbeing Centre will keep the community clinics in Teignmouth.			
	The Health and Wellbeing Centre will make community clinics part of joined up care.

People who sleep in their own beds can have better health.

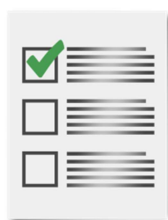
